Recommended first- and second-year courses for Virginia Community College (VCCS) and Richard Bland College (RBC) Students

VCU recommends that VCCS and RBC students participate in the Guaranteed Admission Agreement with VCU by completing either the one-year General Education Certificate (for VCCS students) or the two-year A.S., A.A., or A.A.&S. degree prior to transferring to VCU. Students wishing to transfer to the School of Engineering must have a 3.0 GPA with no grades below a C. Also, B grades or better must be attained in mathematics, sciences or engineering courses.
